Classic Vehicle Terms and Conditions 2019

Please read and take note of the following Terms and Conditions:

1. All fees due must be paid in full at the time of booking.
2. Entry time for classic vehicles will be between **07.00 and 9.15am latest**. Entry will not be guaranteed after 9.15am without prior permission from 07759 076307 by Tuesday 30th April latest. We will try to help you out but the organising committee cannot accept lateness and you may be asked to park in the public car park and will have to pay any additional entry fees. Please remember you can arrive on Saturday 4th May after 12.00pm and stay overnight at your own risk. Limited facilities will be available.
3. All classic and ex-Military vehicles must enter via Gate 'B' off Honeybottom Lane located on the northern side of the airfield off the junction with the B4017, at Whitecross, Boars Hill, Abingdon.
4. All Vehicle Passes must be displayed in the front windscreen upon arrival for identification.
5. Additional passenger's tickets must be shown on arrival.
6. The Speed limit on all parts of the showground is 15 mph max. In 2018 2 traders / vehicle owners were banned from returning due to excess speed within the showground. Both the Army and AA&CS do not tolerate speeding on the airfield.
7. Dogs are welcome. Please ensure that they are kept under control and on a lead at all times. Abingdon Airfield will be active throughout the day and potential straying of dogs could halt proceedings. Any fouling must be cleared and disposed of accordingly. Please do not use the general waste or recycling bins. If a dog waste bin is not available please take it home.
8. Owners/drivers & occupants must comply with all Health & Safety regulations observing any 'NO SMOKING' signs close to your parking location. All instructions given by site marshals / staff and notices must be complied with. No re-fuelling or maintenance of vehicles is to take place within the site during public opening times.
9. No person or persons shall tamper or interfere with any aircraft or any equipment in connection with any aircraft or related services.
10. It is the responsibility of all owners / drivers / occupants to ensure their area is left clean and tidy before departure. This includes all litter, which must be put into the site waste and recycling bins provided or, take it home with you. Any damage caused to the site must be repaired by the owner / driver before departure.
11. **No movement of vehicles within the showground will be allowed until 17.30pm or as advised by the announcer over the PA system** to allow members of the public to vacate the area. If you require an earlier departure please contact a marshal or member of staff and we will do our best to escort you off the showground but please note this will depend on staff availability and crowd numbers and density. Anyone found to have moved before this time will be banned from future shows. We are sorry but we have to take the safety of the general public seriously.
